However, next term, we are seeking to widen our reach and we are looking to embrace older adults through a couple of exciting initiatives.

British Judo's 'Finding Your Feet' Safer Falls for Older Adults Course

Through our Friday afternoon school judo club in the first instance, we shall invite grandparents of our club members (but also anyone else who fancies it) to take part in this course that is aimed at older adults and includes falling safely and learning how to get up after a fall. Judo naturally has a lot to offer in this area and we feel this could be a big help to our local community.

Following an introductory course in the first half term, we shall then invite all participants to attend a follow up 'Hope explored' course through our Wednesday afternoon youth church small groups, introducing the Christian faith. This will take us up to Christmas, when we shall advertise all local churches' Christmas services and encourage participants to attend.



We hope that this combination of a practical and spiritual off to our pupils' grandparents' generation will be well received by our wider school community.

Preacher; Bible readers; prayer leaders; musicians; car park/welcome team; refreshment assistants; audio/visual technicians.

For the congregation ask God to:

- Draw newcomers and those who are irregular or hesitating about coming.
- Prepare the hearts of His people and transform them through His Word and His Spirit.
- Help people to love and serve one another.

For yourself ask God to:

- Prepare your heart and change you.
- Use you to help others take a step towards love and obedience in Christ.
- Give you wisdom about where to sit, who to welcome, listen to, encourage, pray with.
