Welcome to your A-Level Business Bridging Unit! This unit is designed to help you transition from GCSE to A-Level Business. You will engage in a variety of activities that will introduce you to key concepts, theories, and real-world applications of business.

Activity 1: Reading Assignment

Read "The Lean Startup" by Eric Ries (you can buy a second hand copy, or use the following audiobook link: <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=vVlJfVZOTGo>). This book will introduce you to key concepts in entrepreneurship and business strategy. After reading, write a one-page summary of the main ideas and concepts you've learned - bring this with you to our first lesson.

Activity 2: Case Study Analysis

Here is a report on the marketing strategy of Netflix (<https://www.simplilearn.com/tutorials/marketing-case-studies-tutorial/netflix-marketing-strategy>). Tell me about the business model, competitive advantage of Netflix, and key challenges the business faces. Write a 500 word report detailing your analysis and findings - bring this with you to our first lesson.

Activity 3: Business Plan

Create a basic business plan for a hypothetical startup of your choice - here's some businesses you can choose from (<https://www.nerdwallet.com/article/small-business/business-ideas-for-teens>). This should include the business concept, target market, marketing strategy, and some financial projections. This activity will help you understand the planning and strategic thinking involved in starting a business - bring this with you to our first lesson.

Activity 4: Online Course

Activity 5: Current Events Discussion


