INFORMATION FOR PUPILS

CONDUCT IN THE EXAMINATION ROOM

Pupils should not enter the examination room until given permission by a member of staff. Pupils should enter the examination room in **silence** and **remain silent** for the duration of the examination.

Should you require any assistance, please raise your hand clearly and wait for the invigilator to attend to you.

TIMETABLES/REGISTRATION/START TIMES

- Please **check** your timetable carefully.
- Registration will take place at the usual time each day in your usual form room.
- Each morning your form teacher will instruct you as to when to go to the examination room.
- Most examinations will begin with a period of **silent** revision. Make sure that you have revision with you e.g. A text book or your exercise book.

LOCATION OF EXAMINATIONS/SEATING ARRANGEMENTS

Seating arrangements for all written papers can be found at the end of this booklet. Your seat will be the same number for all examinations in the Sports Hall. Please try to remember your seat number.

It is very important that you make a note of your seat number and sit in the correct seat.

Seats in will allocated a letter and a number e.g.

BAGS AND OUTSIDE COATS

Outside coats, bags will be allowed into the examination room during these examinations. Hang your coat on the back of your chair and put your bag under your desk or chair.

ELECTRONIC DEVICES

Make sure that your mobile telephone is **switched off before** you enter the examination room. Wrist watches of any kind **are not permitted** in the exam room.

USE OF CALCULATORS

Calculators may be used in most examinations. Your subject teacher will tell you if they are prohibited.

You may not use a mobile phone as a calculator.

EQUIPMENT

Pupils must provide all their own equipment. Black ink or ball point pen must be used in all papers. Highlighter pens and correction fluids/pens must not be used in any answer booklets.

You should also bring to all examinations a pencil, rubber and a ruler.

Wrist watches must be placed on the desk for the duration of the examination.

Water bottles must be transparent with no labels. Juice is not allowed without a medical reason.
